1. Federated Farmers lodged an appeal on the Proposed Queenstown

District Plan (ENV-2018-CHC-053). Federated Farmers understands

that all of its appeal points have either been resolved by consent

orders issued by the Court or have been withdrawn by memoranda

previously filed with the Court.

2. However, to the extent that any of Federated Farmers' appeal points

remain live, it wishes to withdraw those appeal points.

3. Federated Farmers is also a section 274 party to various other

appeals, some of which remain live and are the subject of the

upcoming workshop hearing or future hearings. Federated Farmers

wishes to withdraw all remaining section 274 interests it has in the

proceedings.

4. Over the past three years, Federated Farmers has participated

extensively in mediation processes regarding the Proposed District

Plan appeals. After reviewing recent correspondence from the Court

and parties, and after assessing the nature of the remaining issues and

Federated Farmers' internal resourcing constraints, Federated Farmers has

decided to withdraw all of its remaining interests in all remaining topics

and not participate in the proceedings further.

5. Federated Farmers does not consider that any issues of costs should

arise from its withdrawal from the proceedings. However, if any such

issues were to be raised then Federated Farmers would seek to be

heard on that aspect.
