If you make a further submission, you must, within 5 working days of lodging that further submission to the District Council, serve a copy of the further submission on the person who made the original submission. A list of submitter's addresses will be available on the Council website.

Following collation of all further submissions received, the Council will appoint a panel of commissioners to assess the Plan Change and the submissions lodged to it, including further submissions. The Panel will hold a public hearing to enable any submitters to present their submissions verbally.

Following deliberation, a decision will be issued by the Hearings Panel to withdraw, retain or modify the plan change. Any person who was a submitter, or lodged a further submission, and who is not satisfied with the decision reached, may appeal that decision to the Environment Court.
