## PUBLIC NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF PLAN CHANGE TO THE QUEENSTOWN LAKES PARTIALLY OPERATIVE DISTRICT PLAN

Pursuant to Clause 8D of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991 the Queenstown Lakes District Council gives public notice as of **7 October 2004** that it has withdrawn the following Plan Change to the Partially Operative District Plan:

## Plan Change 1: Acoustic Insulation.

The purpose of this Plan Change was to

- improve the amenity of habitable spaces through acoustic insulation in the Queenstown, Arrowtown and Wanaka Town Centre Zones; and
- enable mixed uses in the town centre zones, while avoiding conflicts that may arise due to noise emissions; and
- ensure noise levels within habitable spaces are consistent with the standards proposed by the World Health Organisation (WHO).

The reason for withdrawing Plan Change 1 is that the proposed amendments to clause G6 of the Building Act will largely cover the purpose of the Plan Change and are likely to render the Plan Change unnecessary.
