1.	<p><u>Title</u> Kylie spoke to a PowerPoint presentation. She summarised the key themes arising from parking workshops.</p> <p>Discussion re the introduction of paid parking in different precincts in Wānaka (noting an extended time will be available for locals if resident permit is introduced). The Board noted that parking is finite and it will not be possible to keep adding more areas for parking.</p> <p>Discussion about the introduction of parking charges: Lakefront proposed charges: Area A \$2.00/hour; Area B \$0</p> <p><i>Attachment: Stantec PowerPoint presentation entitled 'WUCCB Parking Workshop 14 March 2024'</i></p>	<p>Questions were raised about the provision of bicycle parking. It was suggested that consideration be given to formalising an area of bicycle parking (Monley Lane at edge of Lismore Park).</p> <p>There was discussion about proposed changes to Seniors' Permit scheme. Board members agreed the scheme should remain in place. Discussion also about a proposal for Local QLDC resident permit and residential parking permit.</p> <p>There are options for residents to influence how parking revenue is spent and funding could be used to introduce public transport.</p>
